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**Likelihood of Happening**

- 1 - Unlikely to happen.
- 2 - May occur at some time.
- 3 - Likely to occur at some time.
- 4 - Very likely to occur.

**Extent of Possible Injury**

- 1 - Remote possibility of harm.
- 2 - Slight injury, minor first aid.
- 3 - Some injury, not too serious.
- 4 - Serious injury or damage.
- 5 - Could cause death or serious injury.
