







USE OF RADIO MICROPHONE ETC. TYPE EQUIPMENT AT RUAS EVENTS.

If you are using any sort of radio microphone/ two way radio etc you must request permission in advance (6 weeks prior to event).

Radio Microphones / Two Way Radios / Wireless video transmission equipment (including Bonded cellular and microwave links) and wireless in ear audio monitoring equipment.

Applicable to any Exhibitors, Demonstrators, Display Acts, Media, Streaming and Photo / Video Uplinks.

Those wishing to use radio microphones, two-way radios, photo / video transmission equipment, IEM's etc., during RUAS events are required to request permission from the Society no later than six weeks prior to the event. This notification should include the number of devices, type of devices, the nature of their use and the radio frequency they wish to operate on.

The Society reserves the right to limit or prohibit the use of any radio frequency emitting devices on the RUAS site where it is considered that its use may: impact on the equipment of the society or that of its main contractors, create a nuisance, or interfere with health and safety communications equipment.

Should any radio transmission equipment be found to interfere with the Society's own equipment or that of the main contractors, including where prior permission had been granted, The Society reserves the right to revoke any permissions, and the operator of that equipment may be asked to change radio frequency or cease using the equipment.

Where an individual or organisation is found to be using radio transmission equipment without prior permission, or in breach of Ofcom licencing requirements, they will be required to cease use of that equipment immediately and the Society reserves the right to impose sanctions on those individuals or organisations as appropriate.
